## **JANUARY NIGHT SKY**

### **The Full Wolf Moon**

“January’s full Moon, the Full Wolf Moon, reaches peak fullness at 2:21 P.M. EST on Friday, January 10, 2020. It can be seen rising from the horizon around sunset that evening.

### **Earth Reaches Perihelion**

On **January 5, 2020**, Earth will be at perihelion. Perihelion is the point in Earth’s orbit where it is closest to the Sun—only 91,398,199 miles away! Given that Earth’s orbit around the Sun is an ellipse rather than a perfect circle, there is a point each year where it is nearest (perihelion) and farthest (aphelion) to our shining star.” *~The Old Farmers Almanac Online*

Lunar eclipses are called blood moons, because of their reddish color. Aside from eclipses, the **January full moon is often called the Wolf Moon**, according to the Old Farmer's Almanac, and may date back to Native American tribes and early Colonial times when wolves would howl outside villages. 🌙
